How to draw a family tree

Teachers' notes:

- 1. A powerpoint is provided in the *For schools* section showing how to build the Beckhams family tree.
- 2. The *database search* on the website allows the collection of names, dates and relationships. These can be noted down before assembling into a tree.
- 3. There are varying degrees of complexity depending on the individual families concerned. A fairly simple tree can be drawn based on Liebe Schneider.
- 4. For increased levels of difficulty, Liebe's brother-in-law Nicholas and his family could be added.

Extension:

- Can the different relationships be identified and named eg uncles, grandparents, cousins?
- Can they draw a family tree for an historic figure eg Henry VIII or Queen Victoria?
